**Tourism Vehicles Licensing Act 1999**

**Tourism Vehicles (Licensing And Control Of Tourism Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 2001**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 39 of the Tourism Vehicles Licensing Act 1999 [Act 594], the Minister makes the following regulations:

**Citation**

1. These regulations may be cited as the **Tourism Vehicles (Licensing and Control of Tourism Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 2001**.

**Amendment of regulation 18**

2. The **Tourism Vehicles (Licensing and Control of Tourism Vehicles) Regulations 2000 [P.U. (A) 215/2000]**, which in these Regulations are referred to as the "principal Regulations", are amended in regulation 18-

(a) by inserting after subregulation (1) the following subregulation:

"(1A) An offer to compound any offence under the Act which is prescribed to be a compoundable offence shall be made in Form 8 of the Schedule."; and

(b) in the national language text, in subregulation (3), by substituting for the word "mana" the word "kepadanya".

**Amendment of Schedule**

3. The Schedule to the principal Regulations is amended by inserting after Form 7 the following Form:
